Hamidreza Zeinali is a Cinema Graduate and Postgraduate in Dramatic-Literature. He was born in Tehran in 1980. He is a member of the Documentary Filmmakers Association of Iran. In addition to filmmaking and teaching at university, he has always been photographing and has more than 15 photo exhibitions in its repertoire.

He gained valuable experience while making several documentaries in different countries. He always tried to select different themes and subjects for his films. During his studies in Germany, he participated in a film workshop and subsequently making a film in Germany. That experience opened a new path to his filmmaking outside of Iran.

The financial resources for most of his film production come from private sectors. He has been trying to represent an independent cinema through

his works and stay away from the Government and State Agencies.

He has directed nine films and led over a dozen Photo Art exhibitions. He received the Best Director award at the 2016 FICTS Festival for his film Flying High, the Best Film award at the 2017 FICTS Festival for his film Unbounded Steps, and Best Director of Photography at the 2019 Pune International Film Festival. Mr. Zeinali is also a member of the Iranian Cinema Association.
